Purpose: The Graduate will support Artscape's Maintenance Department within the Plumbing sub-section. They will form part of the Maintenance team, assisting with and taking responsibility for plumbing maintenance and repairs. All activities must ensure compliance with safety regulations, NHBC standards, and Plumbing regulations.

Main Duties: Duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Assist with the repair and do preventative maintenance work to all the plumbing systems in Artscape buildings
- Perform the duties as specified within the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Plumbing Regulations and the relevant legislation
- Assist the Plumber in ensuring that the Artscape infrastructure is always optimally available

Educational & Experience Requirements

- N3 or Grade 12 qualification or NTC 3 minimum.
- Completed a recognized Diploma/Degree (Statement of Results must be attached).
- Certified Red Seal plumber artisan.
- Grade 12 Certificate (Statement of Results must be attached).
- Working knowledge of plumbing regulations, equipment, and tools.

- Preparedness for overtime, including call-outs during weekends, public holidays, and evening productions as required.
- Proactive mindset with strong problem-solving ability.
- Ability to work collaboratively within a team and under supervision.
- Must reside in the Western Cape (proof of address required).
